We are closely aligned with the Utah Olympic Park and work cohesively with many areas of the park. The mission of the Alf Engen Ski Museum is to preserve the rich history of skiing in the Intermountain Region by providing a world-class facility that highlights the many contributions made in ski area development, athletic competition, snow safety, ski innovation, and ski teaching methods.

The museum hosts approximately 500,000 visitors per year from all over the state, nation, and world. It is a fun, energetic atmosphere with unlimited potential to meet new people and enjoy watching athletes train outside the museum.

Major Tasks/Responsibilities:

Oversee the operation of the ski museum:

- Operate interactive museum exhibits.
- Process payments by electronic means from museum visitors.

- Ensure museum exhibits are clean and functioning properly.
- Other tasks associated with the museum as needed.
